Why We Need to Prioritize?



NYS Funding and How it Works


Each School Building Has a Maximum Cost Allowance (MCA)
MCA calculation is based enrollment / size of building
MCA is Categorized by Additions and Renovations
And then Separated by Building cost and Incidental cost (site work)

The MCA resets every 5 years

How MCA effects Building Work vs. Site Work (comes out of the smaller pool of funding)

Aid ability

Cost over the MCA is not NYS aided Some scope of work does not qualify for state aid Storage, furniture and equipment in the existing building, maintenance/repair work, etc...
