## HORSEHEADS CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT PARENTS' BILL OF RIGHTS RELATING TO STUDENT DATA

The District, in compliance with Education Law 2-d, hereby establishes the following Parents' Bill of Rights in regard to student data:

- 1. A student's personally identifiable information will not be sold or released for any commercial purpose;
- Parents have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of their child's educational record. Procedures for reviewing student records can be found in the Board Policy entitled "Student Records," Policy 5500, Regulation 5500-R;
- 3. Security protocols regarding confidentiality of personally identifiable information are currently in place and the safeguards necessary to protect the confidentiality of student data are maintained at industry standards and best practices. The safeguards include but are not limited to encryption, firewalls, and password protection.
- New York State maintains a complete list of all student data collected by the State and the data is available for public review at www.nysed.gov, or by writing to 89 Washington Avenue, Albany, NY 12234
- 5. Parents have the right to have complaints about possible breaches of student data addressed. Complaints should be directed to the Superintendent of Schools, One Raider Lane, Horseheads, NY 14845.

#### 2016-2017 HEALTH EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

New York State law requires a health examination for all students entering the school district for the first time and when entering Pre-K or K, 2nd, 4th, 7th, and 10th grade. The examination must be completed by a New York State licensed physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.

A copy of the health examination must be provided to the school within 30 days from when your child first starts at the school, and when your child starts K, 2<sup>nd</sup> ,4<sup>th</sup> ,7<sup>th</sup>, & 10<sup>th</sup> grades. If a copy is not given to the school within 30 days, your student will be scheduled with our School Medical provider. Our physical dates are during the school day the months of November, December, March and/or April.

If your child has an appointment for an exam during this school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please notify the Health Office with the date.

We suggest you make copies of the completed forms for your own records before sending them to the school health office. Forms may also be faxed to the Health Office.
