- New ideas and thoughts are being put into the use of ESSER American Rescue Plan funding
- Superintendent offered design input on Center Street design and capital plans are underway through the 2030 plan
- COVID tests are available
- All stadium events are free but in the next 2-3 years, seasonal passes or 'senior passes' for purchase will be available
- Parents night out is planned for October 6, HHS Senior events
- Capital projects are about 6 months behind due to supply chain delays
- Electrical busses not in the near future although NYSED do have plans for percentage of fleet go electric in future
- Phase 2 of elementary buildings construction will happen before new bussing/transportation purchases are made
- District-wide PTO meeting was held in summer discussion around district-wide funds for field trips

Principal's Report

October included a page on the Next Generation Learning Standards as continued support for parents, and also tips on how parents can help at home. There was also a page about tips to help students be successful with homework.
