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### **Tips on How to Prevent Summer Learning Loss**

Summer is an ideal time for students to get outside and be active with swimming, bike riding, and many fun sports. However, summer is also a good time for students to strengthen their academic skills.

Set aside time for your child to **read each day** during the summer break. Just 15 to 30 minutes per day is all it takes! During the summer students have more time to read for enjoyment, which also offers a great opportunity to preserve and strengthen their reading skills. Have your child read both fiction and non-fiction books. To help build comprehension skills have your child share with you about the characters in the story as well as summarize the main idea of the story and the specific details in each chapter.

In **Math**, the students can keep mathematical skills from getting rusty by just taking a few minutes each day to **review basic facts**. They can look at it as a daily challenge to keep getting faster with their answers to the math fa
