








Favorite Hat Day

The Horseheads Fire Department and The Friends of the St. Patrick's Day Parade are sponsoring the Annual Horseheads <u>St. Patrick's Day Parade on Saturday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, at 2:00 pm.</u> Our school has been invited to participate again this year. We have participated the last few years and had a wonderful time! This is a fun activity for the Ridge Road students, a great way to show community spirit and also a fun way to celebrate Saint Patrick's Day!

If you are interested in having members of your family participate in the Saint Patrick's Day Parade with other members of our Ridge Road School Community, please review the following information and hand in the permission form by **Tuesday, March 7**<sup>th</sup>. The only requirements from the parade committee members are that we wear green, incorporate a Saint Patrick's Day theme and have fun!

**Decorating the Float:** Any parent and student wishing to help decorate our float, can meet us in the **Ridge Road Parking Lot from 10:00 am-11:30 am on Saturday morning.** Bring any green decorations you have that would look good on our float. We will have the arch balloons on the back of the float as we have done in the past. (If you are creative or artistic, we really need your help for this decorating!) We are using a pick-up truck and small trailer and we can decorate the trailer as our float. The kids can take turns riding on the trailer and walking in the parade to hand out candy. We will stop two or three times during the parade for the students to change spots.

**<u>Parade:</u>** We will meet at the High School Parking lot at 1:15. **The parade starts at 2:00.** We will go on Sayre Street to Main Street. The parade goes to Hanover Square and turns on Franklin Street. The parade ends right at the square as it turns onto Franklin Street.

**<u>Candy</u>**: Our PTO will purchase some candy for the kids to hand out in the parade. We would also appreciate any candy donations from parents for the parade. You can drop it off at school the week of March  $6^{th}$  or bring it to our decorating session on Saturday morning.
