Also, we plan to run a normal morning schedule that is focused on academics. Please do not allow your child to come to school dressed in costume or with make-up on. All students will have an opportunity to change into their costumes prior to the parade. For safety reasons, we ask that adults not go to the rooms prior to the parade. If you need to help dress your child, please make sure you have arranged this with your child's teacher prior to the day of the parade.

Backpack Reminder from Mrs. Tenbus

Dear Parents,

As the school year gets into full swing, I just want to send a reminder on correct backpack use. Improper use of a backpack can cause injuries to children with back pain that may continue into adulthood. Backpacks should be less than 15% of your child's body weight according to most experts. Please remind your children to wear both straps, empty out the unnecessary items from the backpack and that the straps are adjusted properly to allow for proper fit. Please remind your child to let you know if they are experiencing back, shoulder, or neck pain after carrying their backpack.
