- Accepted for admission to an accredited institution of higher learning.
- Demonstrated interest and involvement in school/community activity.

## **Application Process:**

- 1. Copy of birth certificate or naturalization
- 2. School Counselor letter confirming current enrollment status
- 3. Copy of a **letter of acceptance** by an accredited institution (Ex.: College, University)
- 4. Description of your **goals**, values, and objectives in higher education
- A list of school/community involvement/achievements, awards
- 6. Name two (2) non-family character references (names/contact numbers)
- 7. A brief essay on your Finnish heritage/experience (Ex: What does your Finnish heritage mean to you and/or how are you involved in Finnish culture and activities?)
