

Drop-off & Pick-up:

• Morning Drop-off:

- Please park in a spot (not at the sidewalk) & walk your child to the cafeteria door. The doors will open no later than 9:00 AM.
- After 9:05, you will need to sign your child in at the main office.
- If you have an older sibling, they must still be in school at 8:15 (tardy bell).

Afternoon Pick- up:

- Please park & walk into the cafeteria to sign your child out. You MUST sign daily.
- If someone different than your 'approved list' is picking up your child, please let us know on a gold 'Go Home' note. Identification will be checked until we get to know that person.
- Please fill out a gold 'Go Home' note for early pick-up. This will occur in the main office.
- Please exit the cafeteria even if you need to pick up an older child. We need to set up
 the space differently for K-4 dismissal. Please no running/playing in front of the school if
 you are waiting. Classes are in session in the library at this time.

Conversations with Teachers:

 Please save conversations with teachers about academics, etc. at another scheduled time. Pick-up and drop-off are busy times and it is not the ideal opportunity for these types of conversations.

- Please no treat bags or toys (including rings in cupcake frosting)


Out of School Party Invitations
