## **SENIOR YEAR**

- \*ALL YEAR: do your BEST work in all classes---Although when your transcript is submitted for college applications (between October—December typically), your rank & cumulative average do not include the Senior Year Courses, we DO SEND MID-YEAR SENIOR TRANSCRIPTS to ALL 4-Year Colleges, and SEND FINAL TRANSCRIPTS to the college you will attend.
- \*<u>SEPTEMBER--NOVEMBER:</u> Register take or retake the SAT and/or ACT College Admissions Tests for October or November (December at latest usually)
- \*ALL YEAR: Work with the CDC Rep re: Career Shadowing, Panels, & Internships
- ❖<u>SEPTEMBER--MARCH:</u> Meet with COLLEGE ADMISSONS REPS at our High School, at COLLEGE FAIRS like CID at the Arnot Mall in October, and at Open Houses on Campus
- ❖<u>SEPTEMBER</u>—<u>DECEMBER</u>: Request <u>LETTERS</u> OF <u>RECOMMENDATION</u> from Academic Teachers, Coaches, Club Advisors, Community Service Supervisors, & School Counselors (make sure to request at least 10 school days ahead of any deadline!)
- ❖<u>SEPTEMBER</u>—<u>DECEMBER</u>: If considering D1/D2 college athletics, register with the NCAA Eligibility Center On-Line & have Guidance send your HS TRANSCRIPT
- \*ALL YEAR: Look for & apply for SCHOLARSHIPS at colleges, through local organizations, and through on-line database searches

## **SENIOR YEAR**

## **SEPTEMBER-DECEMBER:**

Begin COLLEGE APPLICATIONS, either online or paper forms (or earlier...The Common Application On-Line is activated around August 1st)

- •Check with each college to see what materials are needed for your application. Any materials needed from the Guidance Office must be requested well ahead of the deadlines
- •Check with each college to see if they accept SAT/ACT scores directly from the HS Transcript –or- if scores must be sent directly from the Testing Agencies.
- •Create or update a STUDENT RESUME & STUDENT RECORD SHEET
- •(this must be received in the Guidance Office for a Counselor Recommendation) CHECK DEADLINES at each college to be considered for MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS!

OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup>: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FASFA) is available for parents and students to submit.

•<u>December 11th:</u> Guidance Office deadline for admissions materials that are due January 1st (for other deadline dates, applications must be turned into Guidance 10 working days before any deadline date)
