2024-2025 BUSING FORM

On Monday, May 6th, the Transportation Department sent the 2024-2025 School Year Busing Form to parents/guardians to complete. This process was implemented in 2023 and has been refined for the upcoming school year. The busing form helps the Transportation Department determine the schedule and routes. This form must be completed for every student. Please stay tuned for more information.

MENINGITIS VACCINE

Please note before school this September:

- Your 12th-grader must receive a booster of the meningococcal vaccine (unless the first dose was received after turning 16). This booster is required because protection from the vaccine decreases over time.
- If your child had one or two doses of the meningococcal vaccine prior to their 16th birthday, he/she must have a second dose to begin school in September*.

• The vaccine may be given by your primary provider or the Chemung County Health Department. For information on how to get the vaccine at the Health Department and insurance coverage, call (607)737-2028.

To learn more about this and other vaccination requirements in New York State, visit <u>www.health.ny.gov/immunize</u>. For specific questions about your child, please contact your primary provider. Questions for the High School Health Office, call 795-2500, x1622.

*Public Health Law requires that all students meet immunization requirements. Students transferring within New York State have 14 calendar days to submit required immunizations. Students transferring from out of state or out of country have 30 days to submit required immunizations.

HEALTH EXAM REQUIREMENT FOR THE 2024 – 2025 SCHOOL YEAR

As of July 1, 2018, New York State law requires a health examination for all students **entering a school district for the first time and when entering 9th and 11th grade.** A physical dated on or after September 5, 2023 is needed for the 2024-2025 school year. The examination must be completed by a New York State licensed physician, physician assistant, or nurse practitioner.

- A copy of the health examination must be provided to the school within 30 days from when your child first starts at the school and when your child starts 9th and 11th grades. If a copy is not given to the school within 30 days, the school will contact you.
- If your child has an appointment for an exam during this school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please notify the Health Office with the date.
- Communication between private and school health staff is important for safe and effective care at school. Your healthcare provider may not share health information with school health staff without your signed permission. Please talk to your provider about signing their consent form for the school at the time of your child's appointment for the examination.

We suggest you make copies of the completed forms for your own records before sending them to the school health office. Forms may be emailed or faxed to the nurse. Please see our contact information below.

SPORTS & PHYSICALS

Physicals will be provided in the High School Health Office on August 14th starting at 8am. Sign up in Athletics. The physicals are for any student interested in playing a sport during the 2024-2025 school year. A physical dated on or after 8/1/23 is needed for a fall 2024 sport. The sport physicals provided by the school are for students that do not have a primary care provider.

MEDICATION PICK-UP

New York State regulations require all medication left at school at the end of the school year be discarded. This includes inhalers and Epi-pens. Unless your child has current permission to self-carry their medication, the school is not able to allow your child to bring the medication home themselves. If you need to make special arrangements to pick up medication, please call the health office. *Medications not picked up will be disposed on June 26, 2024, at 3 PM*

As a reminder, if your student will be returning next year New York State requires a new medication order every school year (every 12 months).

If your student needs to take medication during school hours, we require:

✓ A NYS provider order that is also signed by the parent/guardian. Medication forms are available on the district web site or may be obtained from the school health office. Your health care provider may also use their own form if it includes the required information.

- ✓ The parent/guardian must have the medication delivered directly to the school nurse by an adult. Medication cannot be sent in with the child.
- Medication must be in a properly labeled original pharmacy container. Over the counter medications must be in their sealed original packaging and match the provider order. If necessary, ask your pharmacist to give you a second identically labeled container for any prescription medications your student will take at school as we cannot accept them in any other container.
- ✓ At the end of the school year, medications at school must be picked up by an adult or they will be disposed of after the last day of school.
- ✓ Medication orders must be renewed annually.
- ✓ If your child's provider has determined that your child may be independent and self-administer/carry their medication, please have your healthcare provider complete the appropriate portion of the medication form. This also requires parent consent and evaluation by the school nurse.
