### **Horseheads Central School District Bus Request Process for 2023-24**

***There are three ways to submit your busing request information. If you have more than one child in the district, submit a form for each child by June 23. If you do not need busing next year, please still submit a form indicating that you do not require busing for your child.***

1. **If you have a Parent Portal account and you have downloaded the Schooltool app** for your mobile device, tap the app to access your Parent Portal account. Once you've logged in, your base screen should say FORMS at the top. Tap FORMS and use the mobile app instructions [here](#). If you do not see FORMS at the top, you may be using the web version. Please see the instructions in #2 below or download the Schooltool app wherever you access apps for your mobile device.
2. **If you have a Parent Portal account and you use the web version to access it** – either from a desktop or on your mobile device – go to the site using the Parent Portal Login menu item on our website or this link: (<https://schooltool.horseheadsdistrict.com/sthhWeb/default.aspx>). Use the instructions [here](#).

Please note: If you are on a mobile device, once you log in, tap Menu at the top right and select Full Site. You will be asked to log in again. Instructions are [here](#).

*Using your Parent Portal account will allow you to submit your information without having to enter your child's ID number. It will be submitted automatically through your Parent Portal account.*

3. **If you do not use the Parent Portal**, submit your busing information via the form at the link or QR code below. Please note that if you use this form, you will need your child's ID number. The ID number can be found in your Parent Portal account or your PaySchools account (if you have these accounts), or on your child's report card. If you still do not have your student's ID number, contact the school office. Please complete the form whether or not you have the ID number.

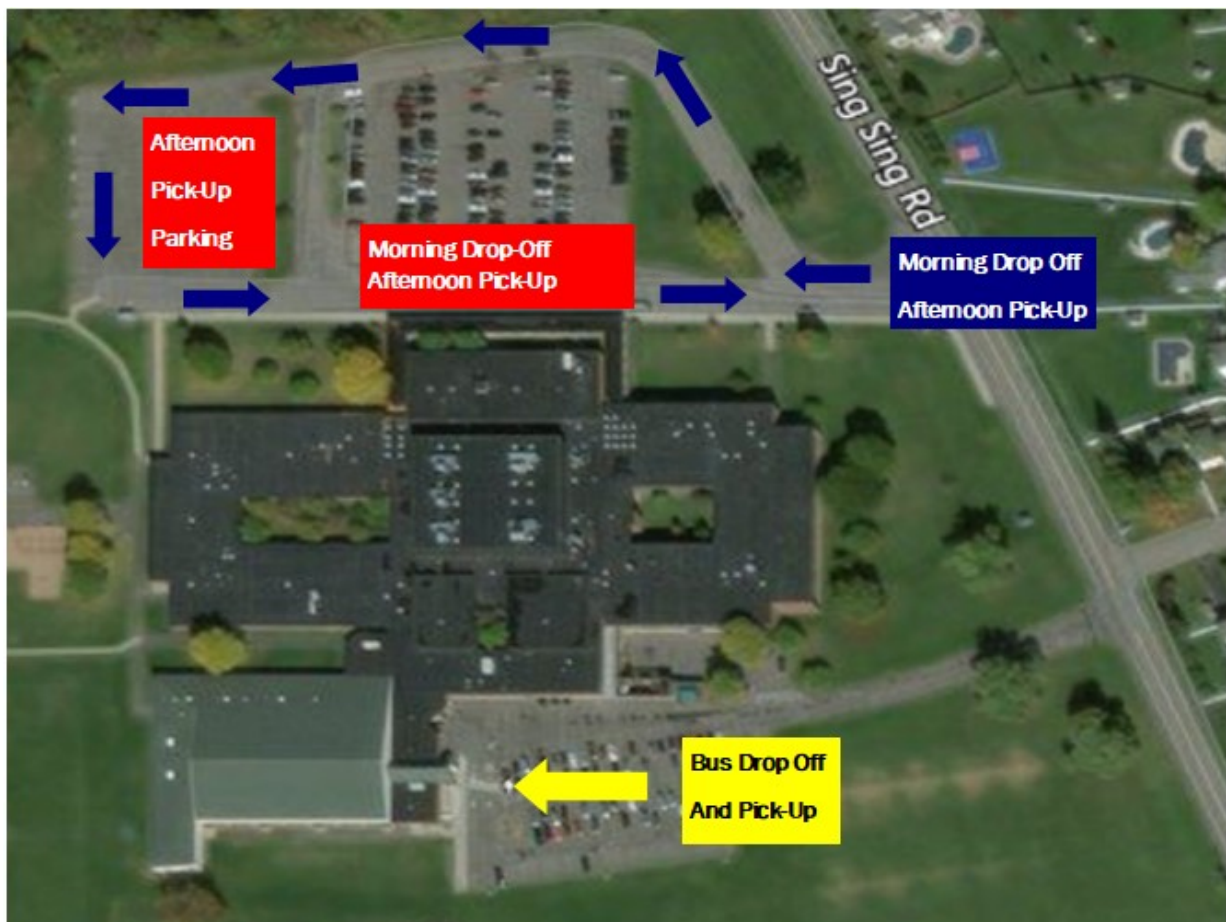


## Drop Off and Pick Up your Student

We have had an increase in the number of students being dropped off at school, due to the beginning of spring sports. Please take this into consideration and get to school early. We ask that you help alleviate unnecessary wait time by following these simple procedures:

- Utilize the entire drop-off and pick-up lane. Please do not wait until you have pulled up to the entrance to drop off or pick up your students. Approximately 10 cars can drop off and pick-up students simultaneously. Please stay in line. **Do not drop students off in parking lots or roadways, as it is not safe and slows traffic.**
- Students should exit the vehicle as soon as it is safely stopped. Please be sure students have all of their belongings ready to go.
- Students should be walking in the door no later than 7:40. This will allow them to be in their first period class by the 7:45 tardy bell.
- As the weather warms, we will have more students walking to and from school. Please watch for them crossing the road.

## **Pesticide Application**

New York State Education Law Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty and staff, regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Horseheads School District is required to maintain a registry of persons in parental relation, faculty and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are **not** subject to prior notification requirements:

- A school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application
- Anti-microbial products
- Nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- Nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- Boric acid and di-sodium octaborate tetrahydrate
- The application of EPA designated biopesticides
- The application of EPA designated exempt materials under Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 152.25

The use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects, including venomous spiders, bees, wasps and hornets. In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good-faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification registry.

If you would like to receive 48-hour prior notification of pesticide applications that are scheduled to occur in your school, please complete the attached form and return it to Tony Stager, the Horseheads School District pesticide representative at: Horseheads School District, Facilities Services, 507 Fletcher Street, Horseheads, NY 14845. You may also fax this form to (607)795-2595.

Please note: Four times per year via newsletter or equivalent, a written announcement concerning impending pesticide applications, pesticide use, "emergency" applications and any other associated pesticide use will be provided. This will occur at the beginning of the school year, at the end of the winter recess, the end of the spring recess and the end of the school year. ### **Forty-eight Hour Pesticide Application Prior Notification Form**
