Carnival: May 31, 2024 6-8 PM
We reviewed everything that is already set from the last meeting. Melissa will put volunteers into the spread sheet with their position as they sign up and will be responsible for walking around during carnival to make sure everything is all set; she will fill prizes as needed. Miranda will be the 'face' of the carnival and the 'go to' person for all volunteers. Jackie will oversee everything money related. She will check the banks and exchange money as needed. Desirae will work the raffle table. She has set up the following raffles so far:

- Gift basket from The Little Lounge
- Yard Creations from JP
- Wegmans $\$ 100$ gift card
- Seabreeze tickets

She will also put together baskets from leftover Scholastic items that we have. Jackie will put a Sams Club order in the week of carnival. We need to order sand art supplies and give the dum dums to Adam so he can put colors on them for the game. Jackie will sort the prizes into small/large bins. Miranda will put together the ticket bags. We need 130 more bags that will include 20 tickets, a wristband and Texas Roadhouse Coupon. The bags that are already filled need a Texas Roadhouse coupon added to them. We need to get the 'shower caddy's' out so we can have them ready with prizes and tootsie rolls. We still need to pay the balance on the inflatables. The Last Stand will bring their ice cream truck to carnival and donate $10 \%$ of sales to Ridge Road. We talked to them and told them we will be selling snow cones and they said that was fine. The ice cream truck will be near the playground at the kindergarten door and Texas Roadhouse will be set up by the bus loop. Jackie is going to order one more thing of tickets for carnival so we have enough extras for the volunteers. Miranda will give the volunteers 10 free tickets when they show up for their shift.

## $4^{\text {th }}$ grade Unity Day: June $11^{\text {th }}$

The shirts are ordered and will be delivered in 2 weeks. Jackie will freeze the freeze pops.

## 4th Grade Celebration: June 7 ${ }^{\text {th }}$

Tanglewood will be coming from 11:30-12:15 and costs $\$ 200$. The fire department will be coming to do water activities with the students, Mrs. McGrain is setting it up. We will need to count how many bandanas and tie die we have and how much to order. We prefer the spray tie dye. We will use rubber bands from the closet. We will need parent helpers for this day. We will supply chips, Gatorade, water, cookies, and pizza (including Gluten Free).

## Kindergarten Orientation: May 22 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$

We need to order white popcorn bags, treats, coffee, juice and 1 tray of Danishes. At Sams club we will get 1 container of OJ, 1 container of apple juice and order the Danish tray ahead of time. Jackie will pick up the order. We will make coffee at school. We have welcome bags with welcome Ridge Road coloring books, crayons, and sunglasses.

## Pre-K Celebration: June $\mathbf{2 1}^{\text {st }}$ at 9:30 in the café.

We need to check and see if we have a helium tank for the balloons. Last year's budget was $\$ 125$ and we voted to increase it to $\$ 150$ this year. The teachers will purchase items and be reimbursed. There are 72 students. We thought about buying a banner that we could reuse every year, a cloth one would last longer than a vinyl one. We will ask the pre-k teachers if that is something they are interested in and get their input. If they want to purchase one, we will add $\$ 50$ to the budget.

## Blue Ticket Reward: June 25 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ :

We will have a cool treat to reward students with. We want to get ice cream cups. Walmart has them in 12 packs. We would spend $\$ 170$ for 500 cups. We would like it if we could purchase all vanilla. We will get chocolate sprinkles and Desirae will donate rainbow sprinkles. We will purchase fruit pops for students that are dairy free.

## End of year staff luncheon: June 26 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ at 12:00:

We will contact Emily from Texas Roadhouse. Our current budget is $\$ 850$ but we will ask Emily if we need to increase it. Last year we had speedies, tators, corn and salad. Desirae will make a cookie cake and a couple Gluten Free cookies. We will have door prizes. We will decorate with summer decorations that we have. We have about 80 staff members for the lunch.

## Budget vote and candidate forum:

Melissa will connect Sarah and Sam from the district on an email so they can coordinate announcements. Sarah will put something on social media about the budget vote encouraging families to vote.

## Last day of school for students: June $\mathbf{2 6}^{\text {th }}$

We will have arches and bubbles.
