Competition Instructions

- You will be given a minimum of 5 minutes prior to the competition to test the sound system and piano the day of the competition. You will be assigned a specific time.
- You will have a total of 12 minutes for your presentation.
- 3. Please prepare two selections showing different styles of music. It is important that the selections are a contrast in genre not two movements of the same piece. You may choose to perform in two categories (instrumental and/or vocal presentation) within the 12-minute allotted period of time.
- 4. Piano accompaniment is required of all soloists unless a selection specifically does not require accompaniment.

Note: If your selection includes long "accompanist only" passages, please attempt to shorten those passages if at all possible.

Pre-Recorded piano accompaniments may be used under certain circumstances if approved beforehand with the committee.

- 5. Memorization is encouraged but not required. However, memorization will be considered as an advantage by the judges.
- 6. Poise, presentation, and musical ability will be considered by the judges.
- 7. Please provide the three judges with a copy of each musical selection.
- 8. Please use the microphone to introduce yourself and your accompanist, and to announce the titles and composers of the musical selections to be performed. The microphone may also be used, if desired, for the performance.
- Your music teacher(s), family, and friends are most welcome to attend the Competition.

The top three winners will receive their prize at our annual luncheon on Thursday, May 15, where each will perform one selection. Meals are provided for each winner and one guest. Additional guests extra charge.
