Supporting Early Literacy: Imagination Library

Horseheads Central School District has partnered with United Way of the Southern Tier to help more families enroll in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a free monthly book program for children from birth to age five. Any child under age 5 living in Chemung, Schuyler, Steuben, or Yates counties is eligible, regardless of family income. Enrolled children receive an age-appropriate book mailed to their home each month, supporting early literacy from the very beginning.
