Dear Parents and Guardians:

The 2022-23 school year begins for students Tuesday, September 6. Information from schools and our transportation department has been sent. There is a great deal to share, and we ask that you bear with us as we seek to meet New York State parent notification requirements and make sure you have the information needed as we begin this school year.

### Health protocols

As we prepare for the opening of the 2022-23 school year, we continue to follow state and county health protocols for COVID and other health matters. Our plan is to open schools as normal, and we wish to remind everyone of the importance of the health protocols of staying home when ill, testing for COVID, and washing hands thoroughly and frequently. If your student tests positive for COVID, please follow state and county protocols for isolation before returning to school. As was the case at the end of last year, masks are optional for students and staff. Those wishing to wear masks are welcome to do so, and we ask everyone to respect this personal choice. #### Safety

In the coming school year, our buildings will be strengthening some of our safety protocols. As a result, procedures at the school may be less convenient than in the past. We are currently reviewing our visitor identification process as well as working to minimize the number of entrances open during arrival and dismissal times at all school buildings. Also, in our continued collaboration with the Village of Horseheads, the district will be adding additional school resource officers, with the goal of having one in each of our educational complexes. The recruitment process is currently underway, and the district will bring these new SROs to service as soon as possible. Further safety upgrades and processes will be shared as they are implemented.

As we strengthen our protocols, we would like to remind everyone that if you have a safety issue to report or if you hear a rumor, we ask that you contact us directly. Contact your child's school or a district office or call our **Safe Schools Line at 607-795-2044 or 1-800-305-4984**. We ask that you provide as much detail as possible. Additionally, so that we may fully research issues of concern, we ask that you provide us with your name and phone number when you call. This will help in any investigation that the district and/or law enforcement conduct. The information will be kept as confidential as possible under the law. Sharing your contact information allows the district to respond to you directly for more information.

#### School Meals

Last year, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) provided subsidies to school districts in order to offer free school meals to all students. The USDA has discontinued this program beginning this school year. **The district will resume our regular meal pricing program**, but please be aware that the free/reduced program is still in effect. Lunches in 2022-23 will be \$2.10 for grades PreK-6 and \$2.35 for grades 7-12. Breakfast is \$1.25 for PK-12. ### School Physicals and Immunizations

New York State has resumed the requirements for physicals and immunizations for the 2022-23 school year. This means that students must have all state-required immunizations within 14 days of the start of school. Additionally, parents/guardians must submit a school health examination (or physical) within 30 days of the start of school. School physicals are required for grades PK or K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11.
