Capital Project Vote Tuesday, December 7

We wish to remind you of our 'Horseheads 2030: Continuing Our Build' capital project vote Tuesday, December 7, 7 am. to 9 p.m. in the Horseheads High School South Gym. All district residents—including renters, residential property owners, and others—are eligible to vote if they are 18 or older, are a U. S. citizen, have lived in the district at least 30 days prior to the vote, and are not restricted from voting based on election law.
