As we move into spring, we wish to update you on a few items:

• The Greater Southern Tier BOCES will hold a public capital project vote Tuesday, March 22, from Noon to 8:00 p.m. at their Bush, Coopers, and Wildwood campuses. All those age 18 and older who reside in the GST BOCES component districts are eligible to vote March 22 at any of these sites.
