Dear Parents and Guardians:

The 2022-23 Budget Vote/Board of Education Election is tomorrow (Tuesday, May 17), from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the Horseheads High School South Gym. All district residents are eligible to vote, as long as they are U.S. citizens, are 18 years of age or older on the day of the vote, have lived in the district for at least 30 days prior to the vote on May 17, and are not restricted from voting in general elections based on election law. Note that a resident does not need to own property in order to vote. Please vote tomorrow.

The district will continue to provide home COVID test kits as long as we receive them from the state. Please note that expiration dates for these tests regularly get extended by the FDA, so if you have a kit with a date that has passed, the tests could be still acceptable to use.
