The following supplies will help your child to get the first day of school off to a good start:

- o 1 marble composition notebook (hard covered, no spirals)
- 4 boxes of 12 pencils (Ticonderoga are preferred.)
- 1 package of cap erasers
- o 2 large glue sticks
- o 16 fine tip dry erase markers
- 1 package of sharpened colored pencils (Crayola Twistables preferred)
- 2 Highlighters (two different colors)
- Pointed-tip scissors (at least 7 inch student scissors)
- 1 cloth or canvas pencil pouch (not a pencil box) that can hold scissors, at least one box of colored pencil, and one glue stick
- 1 large box of tissues
- Ziploc gallon or quart size bags
- Headphones in a Ziploc baggie labeled with your name
