Senior Year Timeline for Financial Aid and Scholarships

Fall

- > Apply for PIN # for FAFSA at https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/filling-out/fsaid
- > October 1st Fill out FAFSA form with 2017 tax information
- > Attend Financial Aid Night at school
- > Register for the CSS Profile if your prospective colleges require this form
- Begin searching out scholarships at school and online
- Parents should explore scholarships at their place of employment and affiliations such as unions, banks/credit unions, professional/club/membership affiliations, places of worship, Greek life affiliations, etc
- > Review Scholarships and Financial Aid information online for schools where you are applying
- Receive Student Aid Report (SAR) from FAFSA and review for accuracy. Update if needed. Follow directions on form

Winter and Spring

- Begin comparing financial aid award letters from colleges
- Investigate payment options with each college
- > Accept all or part of the financial aid offered; sign and return acceptance letter
- Notify the college you plan to attend
- Send your deposit into college
- Make loan arrangements
